The objective of Chinese Language Program is to help children of professional elites to adjust and connect smoothly to local language and education.

Who can apply to CLP?

1. Student's residency is in Hsinchu city, and meet with below :
 - Children of scholars and technological personnel lived in abroad for more than 2 years.
 - Children of expatriates lived in abroad for more than 2 years.
 - Children of overseas Chinese.
 - Children of overseas businessman.
 2. Children of foreign professionals employed by Taiwan's company or institutes. Foreign professionals must meet the requirements in accordance with the "Act for the Recruitment and Employment of foreign professionals". Foreign language teachers of cram schools are not included.
- ※The above applicants must forward the application within 12 months of his/her arrival to Taiwan.
- ※Oversea countries do not include Chinese speaking countries or cities like: Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau and Singapore.

Application time:

Application is accepted at an announced period, and registration for school in April. The actual date of application will be announced on school's website.

Enrollment :

Enrollment is at the first semester of every school year.

Number of students :

12 students.

How to apply transfer to CLP?

1. Students meet above requirements can contact their origin schools for applying for transfer to CLP program.
2. Parents or the guardian contact the origin school and fill in the Hsinchu city CLP application form. (see Attachment 2) The origin school will conduct the first evaluation.
3. The origin school will forward the application, after first evaluation, to Jian Gong Primary School.

Evaluation Process (Attachment 1)

1. Jian Gong evaluates the application and conduct the review.
 - Students unqualified will stay at the origin enrolled school.

- Students qualified will be informed to take the Chinese language proficiency test.
- 2. Jian Gong identify student's Chinese language level through interview and tests.
- 3. Within 2 weeks after the proficiency test, Jian Gong holds an admission committee.
 - Students unqualified will stay at the origin enrolled school.
 - Students qualified will be admitted to Jian Gong.

How do CPL students learn in Jian Gong?

CLP students' Chinese courses are, pulled out from the homeroom class, taught in CLP classroom.

What documents are needed?

1. Hsinchu city CLP Application Form. (Attachment 2)
2. Student's Passport and copy.
3. Parent's and student's Alien Residence Certificate (ARC) and copy.
4. Parent's (Father's or Mother's) employment certification
5. Previous 2 years' School reports and copy
6. Vaccination records and copy
7. Two 1 inch head shot photos

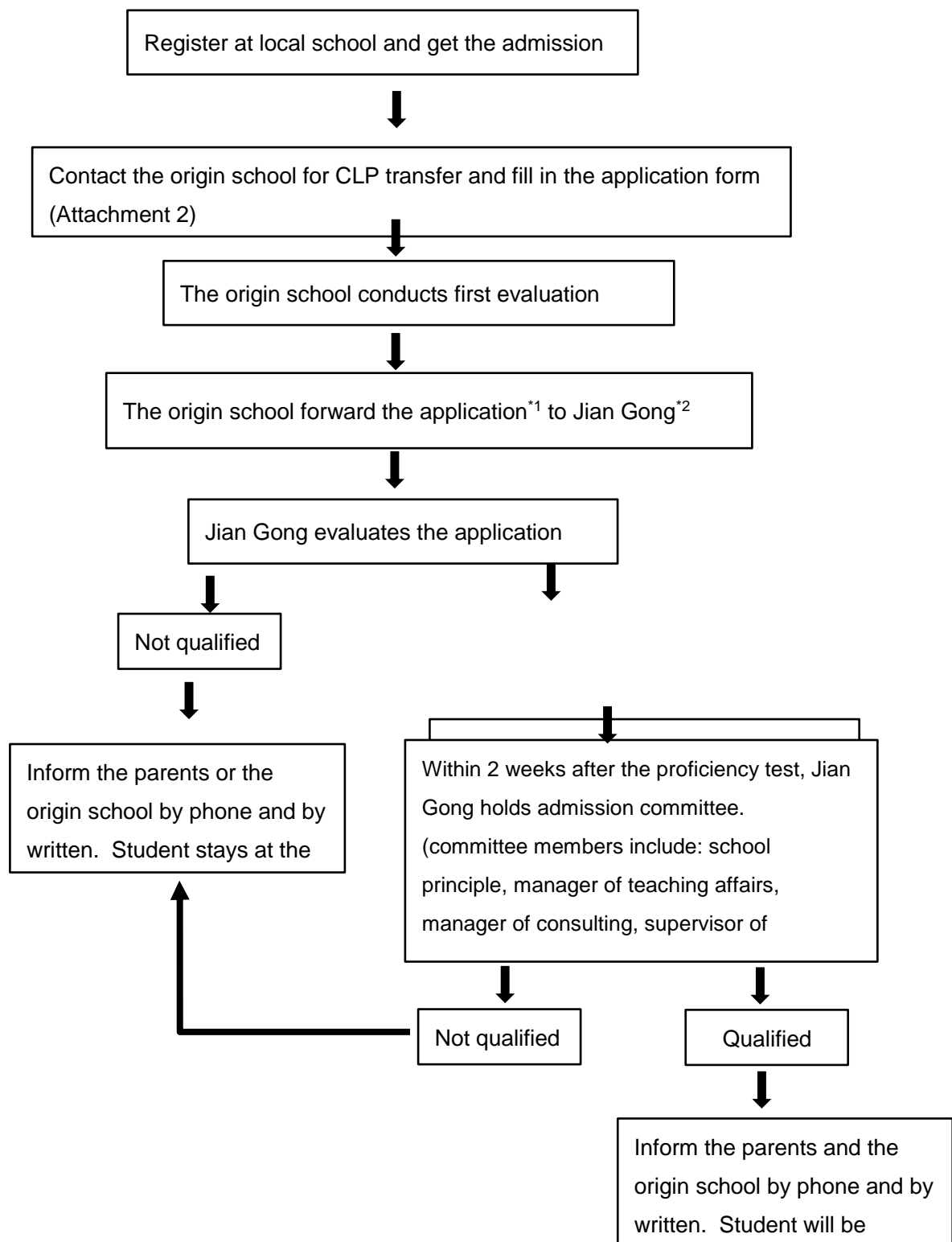
